# TECHNICAL EVENTS

## 1. GAME OF VALOR (online gaming)

### Minutiae :

- i. Maximum number of teams: Two teams are allowed from an Institution/ University.
- ii. Number of participants: Maximum five participants per team.
- iii. Submit the details of participants (Name, Institute, Course, Mobile no, email & Adhaar card copy) to [technorazz@jnujaipur.ac.in](mailto:technorazz@jnujaipur.ac.in).
- iv. If the number of teams is more than, there will be preliminary elimination and selection rounds, and the selected number of teams will play in the final round (Schedule of the selection rounds will be shared with participants).

### Judgement Criteria :

Ranking and Number of Kills.

## 2. ESCAPE ROOM

Escape room also known as Puzzle room is a game in which the players will explore, find clues, solve puzzles and accomplish tasks in one or more rooms to achieve a specific final goal.

**Theme :** The theme of the room will be a Crime Scene

### Minutiae :

- i. Maximum number of teams: Two teams per Institution/University.
- ii. Maximum number of participants: 4 members per team.
- iii. Time starts once the players enter the 1st room, to solve the puzzle and collect the 1st evidence.
- iv. Participants will continue by entering the 2nd room and solve the puzzle and get the 2nd evidence.
- v. Finally they will reach the 6th room, find the correct key and correct door. Find the right suspect present in the room based on the evidence.

### Judgement Criteria :

There will be 2 stages

Stage 1- Solve all Puzzles, find clues and reach the final room

Stage 2- Identify the suspect

The Team completing the tasks in minimum time will be the winner

## 3. ROBOWAR

Nothing beats the brains behind the battle, bots in the war! The students of Diploma, B.Tech., and M.Tech. (All Branches) are invited to participate in this event.

### Minutiae :

- i. One team from each College/University is allowed.
- ii. Maximum number of participants: Three students per team.
- iii. Robot size shall not be more than 60cm \* 60cm \* 80cm (L\*B\*H) cm and maximum weight of 04 Kilograms
- iv. Two Robots will compete at a time.
- v. Robot will be announced the winner of a particular round when the opponent robots get out of the ring, are damaged to be dysfunctional, the robot with the minimal hit/damage during the competition.
- vi. The Maximum time of competition is 4 minutes for each team.

## 4. RC CAR RACE

The Mini Beasts on Track! Bringing Giant Adrenaline. Blink and you'll miss it! All Undergraduate and postgraduate students are invited to participate in this event.

### Minutiae :

- i. One team from each College/University is allowed.
- ii. Maximum number of participants: Three students per team.
- iii. RC car size shall not be more than 12 inches long and weighing up to 1.5 Kg.
- iv. Two cars will compete at a time.
- v. Cars will be put on the previous node after touching or leaving the race tracks during the competition.
- vi. The Maximum time of competition is 4 minutes for each team.

### Judgement Criteria :

Judgment will be based on the distance traveled and the time taken.



## 5. WEB-O-THON

The event evaluates the participant for his/her core skills in developing the dynamic components for a web interface using Javascript, Cascading style sheets and HTML

### Minutiae :

- Maximum number of teams: Five Teams per college/university.
- Number of participants: 1 per team.
- No IDE, No third party code, No Framework is allowed
- The given problem has to be solved in the given time limit

### Judgement Criteria :

Coding style, Time Complexity, Space Complexity

## 7. SHARK TANK

Participants have to pitch their business ideas/modules in the best possible way to a panel of investors to promote investment in their idea.

### Minutiae:

- Maximum number of teams: Two teams per Institution/University.
- Maximum number of participants: 5 members per team.
- Duration: 2 hours
- Deadline for submission of video: September 22, 2025 | Email: sharktank@jnujaipur.ac.in
- Only finalists will present on September 29-30, 2025
- Participants have to submit
  - A support letter from the Institution
  - A brief summary of the business model
  - A short (180 seconds) video showcasing the idea of the start-up
- Cash Prizes for the winner & runners-up

### Minutiae :

- The Ad prepared must not contain obscene words or content and should not hurt the feelings of any culture, religion, caste and society.

### Judgement Criteria :

Theme, Brand Name, Punch Line, Ad Appeal, Team Coordination and Presentation

# CULTURAL EVENTS

## 1. THE GREAT DANCE CHALLENGE

Dancing is a creative form of expression, involving discipline and expression. Dance forms are divided into 2 categories:

- A. Fusion (Theme Based)
- B. Semi Classical/Folk Dance

### Minutiae :

- i. Maximum number of teams: One team per college/university.
- ii. Number of participants: 8-12 participants per team.
- iii. Duration: 5 minutes.
- iv. Requirements: All props, costumes, accessories have to be arranged by the teams themselves. The Music CD/Pen-drive should be submitted to JNU one day in advance.

### Judgement Criteria :

Choreography, Music, Costumes, Coordination and Expression

## 2. STAGE ON RAGE (FASHION SHOW)

Fashion defines your persona through self expression or different roles and forms an important part of one's life. The style quotient of participants will be measured in this Glittering Fashion Show. The teams will be free to perform on a theme of their own choice. Participation is open to all disciplines.

### Minutiae :

- i. Number of participants: 8-12 participants per team.
- ii. Duration: 5 minutes
- iii. Requirements: All props, costumes, accessories, etc., will have to be arranged by the teams themselves. The Background theme music should be submitted to JNU in an audio CD/ Pen-drive, a day in advance.

### Judgement Criteria :

Creativity, Clothing, Foot wear, Accessories/Jewellery or cultural aesthetics, Style Quotient, Overall coordination and presentation, Effective use of Props and Costumes within the allotted time

## 3. CHEF IN MAKING

Do you have it in you to be a master chef? Here's your chance to showcase your culinary skills.

### Minutiae :

- i. Each team should consist of two participants per College/University.
- ii. The teams should report one hour before the start of the event.
- iii. The time duration for the preparation of the menu would be 3 hours (02 hrs for Preparation and 01 hr for the Presentation).
- iv. The teams will be provided with a surprise list of 5-6 ingredients along with the common spices and condiments.
- v. Students can prepare Indian, Chinese, Russian, Continental, etc. Menu from the surprise basket of ingredients.
- vi. During the competition each team would be provided with one work table as cooking counter and sink facilities.
- vii. The menu description has to be submitted just after the completion of the event on below mentioned email id

### Light Equipment (on each table)

- Ladles, Pots, Pans • Strainers
- Bowls • Frying pan, Colander/ Strainer
- Slicers etc

- Refrigerator, Freezers
- Salamander Griller etc.

Any other special equipment e.g. cutters, scoops, mirrors, zesters/ peelers, moulds, special crockery for presentation, etc., are to be brought by the teams.

## 5. CRYPTIC HUNT

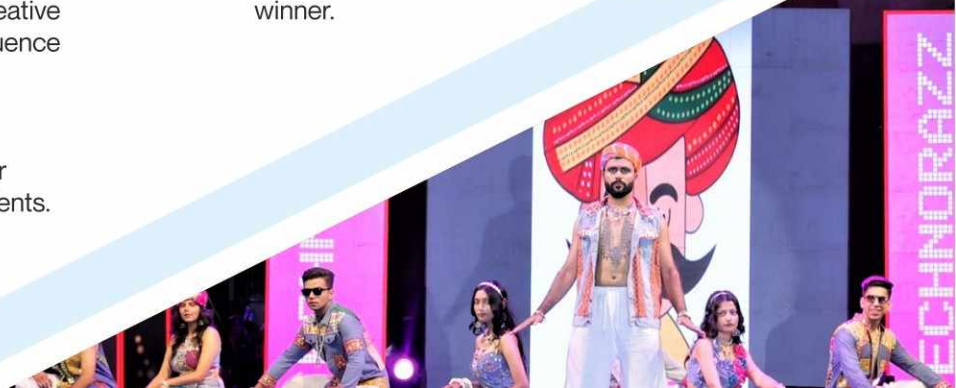
